2. Recommendations must be made by a Lions or Lioness Club, giving full biographical data on the Nominee and stating clearly the basis on which the Club is making its nomination.
3. All informational material must set out plainly the depth and scope of the accomplishment or services and the period the services have been rendered or the general effect on the Community of the achievement.
4. The original of the recommendation must be sent to the Chair of the Outstanding Blind Award Committee (listed below); **AND**
 - One copy to your District's Committee Member;
 - One copy to your District Governor;
 - One copy to the State Office;
5. All nominations to be considered must be in the hands of the Outstanding Blind Award Chair not later than **April 15, 2022**. Decisions of the Committee are final.
6. An Award Plaque will be presented to the winner during the 2019 Georgia Lions State Convention.
7. The Recipient will be presented the Plaque and given a Man and Lady's Hospitality Book by the Council of Governors. All other expenses connected with his or her attendance at the Georgia Lions State Convention must be borne by the Club which made the nomination, or by their Awardee.
8. Copies of all the Nominations will be furnished each Committee Member by the Chair. The Awardee will be selected by vote of the Committee. The Chair will notify the Club submitting the winning entry; each District Committee Chair will notify Clubs submitting nominations from their District the outcome of the committee's selection.

4. The original of the recommendation must be sent to the Chair of the Outstanding Deaf Award Committee (listed below); **AND**
 - One copy to your District's Committee Member;
 - One copy to your District Governor;
 - One copy to the State Office;

ELIGIBILITY:

Every Lion who completes the following requirements between May 1, 20__ and April 30, 20__ may win the Golden Chain Award each year he/she meets the qualifications.

REQUIREMENTS:

The Order of the Golden Chain contains two equally important parts. Part I includes five activities which are mandatory. Part II lists twenty-four (24) activities in which a Lion may participate. To qualify, a Lion must complete all five mandatory activities in Part I and complete eleven (11) of the twenty-four (24) options in Part II.

Completion of Part I and Part II before April 30, 20__ qualifies the Lion for the Award. The completed form must be mailed to the **District Chairman of the Golden Chain Award** – postmark deadline is April 30, 20__

PART I

THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES ARE MANDATORY:

- ___ A. A Lion must attend a minimum of 75% of his/her regular club meetings during the period between May 1, 20__ and April 30, 20__. Missed Meetings may be made up by attendance at a local Board of Directors Meeting or at Meetings of other Lions Clubs.
- ___ B. Sponsor a new member in a Lions Club and help him or her become an active member.

- ___ D. Be active as a local Committee Member.
- ___ E. Attend a Zone or Cabinet Meeting.
